With God's help we will work together with organizations and ministries across the globe to end hunger.

What makes us different

Five important elements contribute to FMSC's missional heart and call to feed God's kids.

Our Christian mission

FMSC is a Christian nonprofit organization. We believe Jesus Christ has called us to feed the hungry and serve those in need. We strive to follow his calling every day in all that we do.

In 2003, 16 years after FMSC was founded (1987), the organization was rededicated to the Lord. We placed our focus back on Jesus Christ, committing to honor Him. He has called us to feed his kids, and with his help we will keep reaching farther around the world until ALL are fed.

Our vision

Through God, FMSC will strive to eliminate malnutrition and starvation in children throughout the world by helping to instill compassion in a generation that hears and responds to the cries of those in need until all are fed.

Pioneering food formulas

Hope begins with nutritious food. FMSC exists to provide this hope in the name of Jesus. Nutrition allows children to grow, thrive and develop to their full potential so that they can become productive members of their communities.

FMSC produces three special MannaPack™ meal formulas developed by food science and nutrition professionals to supplement nutritional needs and reduce problems with malnutrition.

Food distribution partners

Feed My Starving Children partners with organizations around the world to reach God's neediest children. We donate meals to an exceptional network of missions and humanitarian organizations who work hard to get life-saving nutrition into the hands and tummies of those who need it most. By God's grace more than 99% of FMSC meals have safely reached their intended destination.

How our partnership works

Our partners are real heroes. *Every day* they distribute FMSC food in schools, orphanages, medical clinics and feeding programs in 70 countries around the world to break the cycle of poverty.

Developing sustainability

At FMSC, we believe working together drastically reduces the time it takes to transition a person from relief to resiliency. Providing FMSC MannaPack meals to those without a sustainable source of food creates a solid foundation to help them regain their footing and provide for themselves consistently. FMSC partners are embedded in communities and help them advance as circumstances realistically permit. Meal supplies are reduced as the community progresses.

Volunteerism

FMSC exists because of volunteers just like you who generously give their time and energy to feed starving children in desperate need around the world. YOU are an essential part of FMSC.

FMSC doesn't use machines to package our meals because we realize the personal, impactful experience created by packing the meals by hand. It transforms an experience from just "something good to do" into something deeply personal.

FMSC volunteers experience a fun, one-of-a-kind team building experience with co-workers, family, friends and strangers alike. This experience often turns into a desire to do more and reach farther, until all are fed.
