The Mansion, built in 1855, has just undergone a spectacular, privately funded 3-year renovation and reopened as the People's House on July 14, 2018. The Mansion serves as the official residence of the Governor of Illinois, and is a world-class house museum.

Designed by Frank Lloyd Wright in 1902 for Susan Lawrence Dana, a forward-thinking socialite living in Springfield, Illinois. The home contains the largest collection of site-specific, original Wright art glass and furniture in its 35 rooms.
