Colleen Willard's testimony of her healing of an inoperable brain tumor and multiple illnesses diagnosed by Mayo Clinic, has been shared around the world. Since her confirmed healing in 2003, both she and her husband John have traveled the world sharing the Good News. Colleen and her husband John have hosted the Shalom World TV Program "You are Mine" with Fr. Michael Sparrough, which has been aired to over 375 million people, along with Shalom World "Mary Our Mother" program. Colleen is working on her book, bringing to even further depth that "When the Lord Heals, He even goes Deeper".

She made a promise with her husband that they would not be like the other 9 Lepers who did not come back to give thanks. Today, as we draw near to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, may your hearts be moved to give your whole heart and your whole soul to Jesus, the Great Physician, to God Our Father, who created you, and to the Holy Spirit, through the intercession of the Blessed Mother.
